Cost and Lunch

The cost of the trip is £20.00 per pupil, which covers transportation, and is payable via Arbor Payments. Pupils should bring a packed lunch. If the weather does not allow for a picnic in St James' Park, we will eat in the shared spaces of the Science Museum. Pupils may also bring money for the gift shop if they wish.
