Arrangements for Week Beginning 8th June 2026 and End of Year Assessments

I am writing to share important information regarding arrangements for the week commencing **Monday 8th June 2026**, as well as an update on our **End of Year assessments**.

Arrangements for the Week Beginning 8th June 2026

- **Years 10 and 11**
Pupils will attend school each day.
Year 11 pupils have already received a bespoke plan outlining arrangements for the remainder of their examination period.
- **Year 7**
Pupils will attend school **as normal on Monday 8th June and Tuesday 9th June**.
For the remainder of the week, pupils will continue their learning **online from home**.
Work will be set online, and class teachers will be available via Teams to provide support where required.
- **Year 8**
Pupils will learn **online from home on Monday 8 June, Tuesday 9 June and Friday 12th June**.
They will attend school **as normal on Wednesday 10th June and Thursday 11th June**.
On remote learning days, work will be set online and class teachers will be available on Teams for support.
- **Year 9**
Pupils will learn **online from Monday 8th June to Thursday 11th June**.
They will attend school on **Friday 12th June**.
Work will be provided online, with teachers available via Teams to support pupils as needed.
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I will provide a further update regarding arrangements for the week beginning **15th June on Thursday 11th June**.

End of Year Assessments

All **Year 10 assessments** will take place as planned.
Assessments for Years 7–9 will be rescheduled to later in June. This will ensure that all pupils have adequate time to revise and to check in with their teachers before completing their assessments.
