Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you that Year 11 mock examinations will take place from **Thursday 26th February to Thursday 12th March**.

This is an important period in your child's Year 11 journey, and we appreciate your support in ensuring your child is equipped and well prepared for the upcoming mock examinations. I have attached the mock examination timetable to this letter for your information.

At George Eliot Academy, we are committed to providing every pupil with the best possible education and we know that regular attendance will play an important part in your child being able to perform at the best of their ability. 100% attendance during the upcoming mock examinations is our expectation of all pupils.

- Have a clear bottle of water with no labels to take into the examination room

If there are any barriers or challenges affecting your child's ability to attend school during the mock examination period, you must notify the Year 11 team as soon as possible.
