## Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you are all well and enjoying the slightly warmer weather. I would like to share with you some important changes that will take effect from September 2024. These changes are aimed at enhancing our pupils' school experience and ensuring greater consistency in our practices.

From September 2024, all pupils will be required **to change into their PE kits at school** for their PE lessons. This change is being implemented to encourage good uniform standards and to align with practices observed in the majority of the local and national schools. This change allows pupils to maintain a consistent appearance throughout the day and to foster a sense of discipline and pride in their school uniform.

We understand that for a small minority of pupils this change might be difficult, therefore we are organising workshops to support them.

From September, **the school day** will begin earlier for all pupils in Years 7 to 11. Additionally, the finish times will be slightly modified, with Year 7 to Year 10 finishing earlier. The specific timings will be as follows:

- Years 7 to 11 Start Time: 8.25 a.m., lessons start at 8.30 a.m.
- Year 7 to Year 10 Finish Time: 3.10 p.m.
- Year 11 Finish Time: Monday 3.10 p.m., Tuesday-Thursday 4.00 p.m., Friday- 3.10 p.m.
