We encourage pupils to collect their results in person if possible so that they can sign two permission forms whilst they are in school; a Review of Marking form and the Access to Scripts form. If these are not signed on the day, we will need to arrange for pupils to come in sign them as soon as possible after results day.

Please be aware that **we are only able to release results directly to pupils themselves**, and not to anyone on their behalf, unless they have provided a written request to do so naming the person who will be collecting their results. This must be provided in the form of a signed letter or an email to enquiries@GeorgeEliotAcademy.org.uk by Wednesday 20th August. The email must come from the pupil's email account. **Please note that we cannot accept permission over the phone.**

Any results not collected by 11.00am on 20th August will be sent home via their GEA email account and will be first class posted the same day.
