Dear Parent/Carer

We are pleased to inform you that we will be offering an after-school enrichment opportunity for pupils in the form of a structured boxing programme in partnership with Boxing Clever Academy.

The sessions are open for all pupils in Year 7-9 and will take place every Monday from 3:30pm to 4:30pm, beginning on Monday 18th May 2026, and will run for 6 consecutive weeks.

During this time, pupils will be taken to Boxing Clever Academy by school staff and will return to school at 4:45pm. All sessions will be fully supervised by school staff and qualified boxing coaches, and appropriate safety equipment will be provided.

Benefits of participation

This programme has been designed as a positive enrichment experience for pupils. Boxing-based training offers a wide range of benefits, including:

- Improved physical fitness, coordination, and overall health
- Development of discipline, respect, and self-control
- Increased confidence and self-esteem
- Enhanced focus, listening skills, and ability to follow instruction
- Opportunities to develop teamwork and positive peer relationships
- A structured outlet for energy that can support emotional wellbeing and resilience

The sessions will focus on fitness, technique, pad work, and general boxing skills in a safe and controlled environment.

The school have managed to secure an amount of funding to support with these sessions, so a place can be offered at a price of £2 per session. Therefore, if you would like your child to participate, £12 will need to be paid through Arbor Pay by **Thursday 14th May 2026**, but please note this amount is non-refundable

Please be aware that participation in any school activity is a privilege and is conditional upon maintaining high standards of behaviour and attendance throughout the year. These expectations reflect the commitment required to successfully complete the programme and represent our school positively. We will review behaviour and attendance periodically. Pupils who fail to meet these standards may be removed from the programme without refund.

- **Attendance:** Your child must maintain an overall school attendance of 97% or above for the current academic year
- **Behaviour:** Your child must demonstrate our STAR values throughout the academic year, consistently both in and outside of the classroom.
