Dear parent/carer

We are exceptionally pleased to be able to facilitate a school Prom for our Year 11 pupils. We hope to be able to offer this memorable experience to as many of our pupils as possible and finish the school year positively.

Attendance at the Prom is a privilege for pupils to celebrate their time at George Eliot Academy and for those who demonstrate our Star Values.

To attend the Prom pupils MUST:

- Have excellent attendance – 95%+
- Have excellent punctuality
- Attend all lessons – no truancy
- Meet our behaviour expectations

If pupils do not meet these expectations, they will not be granted a ticket to the Prom. This will be an expectation until the Prom event on Thursday 19th June.

As a reminder, pupils can collect 'Passport to Prom' merits (awarded on class charts) for the following:

- Revision tasks completed and handed in to class teachers
- Attending any lunchtime or after school intervention
- Attending holiday revision sessions
- Attending booster sessions before mock and summer examinations
- Anything that is preparing pupils for your examinations
- Tutors to award for 100% attendance each week

The total number of 'Passport to Prom' merits at the end of the initiative will be totalled and the top 5 will win a free leavers hoodie.

Tickets will be £35.00 and are non-refundable. A valid ticket will be needed to gain entry to the event. We reserve the right to prevent attendance at the Prom of any pupil whose behaviour does not meet our high expectations.

We also reserve the right to refuse entry or remove any pupil during the event whose behaviour does not meet the standards required of pupils at the school.

As mentioned earlier in this letter, poor attendance or breaches of the school's Behaviour Policy will put them at risk of missing out on the Prom experience. Please can you stress the importance of attendance and behaviour to your child, to support them with their success in their studies, and so that they have a chance to attend the Prom.
