We are delighted to offer Year 9 pupils the opportunity to visit The Black Country Living Museum and experience a recreation of 19th Century Britain. The day is fully interactive, including an underground mine tour to support learning about the Industrial Revolution. This fun, educational day will be an excellent cultural day for all pupils, and will particularly help support GCSE History pupils with GCSE Medicine Paper 1 as they learn about the society that helped shape the modern world.

Tickets are £28 and will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. This is a voluntary trip and therefore a voluntary cost, so the trip will not run if pupils do not pay to attend. Payments should be made via Weduc Payments. If you need support in paying for this trip, we may be able to support some pupils with some of the cost; please contact me on the email address below.

- Pupils should arrive at the usual start time of 8:25am.
- Pupils will be back around 3:30 depending on traffic.
- Pupils must wear sensible shoes (trainers) and comfortable clothes.
- Please be prepared for the weather: a coat if rain is forecast and sunscreen if it is bright.
- All pupils must bring a packed lunch and a drink with them.
- No spending money is necessary, however if they wish to, they can bring a small amount of money with them for the shops.
